Constitution

Article I- Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization will be known as PackMUG: the NCSU Macintosh Users Group.

Section 2

The purpose of this organization will be to bring together all the Macintosh platform users on the NCSU campus. Since there is a strong and significant Macintosh (Mac) platform user population on campus, we feel that there should be an organization for those Mac platform users to get together and help other users and share our appreciation for the uniqueness of the Macintosh computer and platform with the campus community.

Article II- Membership

Section 1

Membership will be open to all Mac users on campus wishing to join the ever-growing Mac Community and to those who wish to learn more about Macintosh computer and platform and all it has to offer.

Section 2

Selection of members will be open to whoever wishes to join and participate in the activities of the group.

Article III- Officers

Section 1

The elected officers for this club will be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. These officers will make up the Executive Board.

Section 2

The officers sitting on the Executive Board shall be elected by the club members to serve terms of one year, beginning at the first meeting of the club each year.

Article IV- Dues

Section 1

There will be no membership dues for this organization.

Article V- Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution of by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A simple majority of the members present will pass the amendment and voting shall be required. The Secretary will then add the amendment to the constitution and the amendment will be in effect.

Article VI- Meetings

Section 1

The regular club meetings will be determined by the Officers and Advisors of the club. The Executive Board of the club will be responsible for informing members of the club about meetings through list-serves and flyers. The Executive Board will determine when Executive Board meetings are necessary and hold them accordingly.

Article VII- Committees

Section 1

The Executive Board shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.

Article VIII- Amendments

Section 1

Any amendments to the constitution passed under Article V will go here.
