	Section 1 Section 2	 This organization will be known as: PackSUG Purpose of the PackSUG Club: A. To provide a medium of communication for SAS Student Users throughout the campus B. Create an open environment where students (both graduate and undergraduate) can learn about SAS career opportunities, software availability, and research opportunities.
Article II	<u>Membership</u>	
	Section 1	Membership shall be open to all currently enrolled North Carolina State students and to all faculty and staff who use or are interested in SAS.
	Section 2	Membership shall be granted to the club after the person in question has appropriately registered via the web.
	Section 3	Members of the club will not be charged membership dues.
Article III	Officers	
	Section 1	Officers will be elected, by members of the club, at the second official meeting in October.
	Section 2	Elected officers will hold their position the full year unless they are unable to continue their duties or objection from a current member is voiced, in which case, a vote will be held by existing members, honoring the majority's vote.
	Section 3	 Officers will perform duties relevant to continuing the well being of the club and it's members as follows: A. Maintain good standing with the Campus Student Organization Office. B. Consider suggestions made by all current club members. C. Represent the club in a positive manner.

Article IV Meetings

Section 1 Meetings will be held only when needed; the purpose of meetings will be to gather the club's members in order to accomplish tasks that cannot be done via the web. (i.e. elect officers, host speakers, have board discussions).

Article V Amendments to Constitution
