Constitution

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as Passage.

Section 2

The purpose of this club shall be to offer students an opportunity to gather for Christian worship and fellowship.

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in Christian worship and fellowship.

Section 2

While any student member of this organization is on probation, as described in the current Suspension Policy, that student member will be expected not to serve in any leadership, performance, or representation capacity which involves a significant responsibility and time commitment away from academic work.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be the President and the three members of the Leadership Board.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in August. Elections shall be held in May.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

There shall be no dues required of members.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club shall meet weekly.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

When needed, special committees may be formed by the President and Leadership Board.
