

People Like Us Neglect Gravity's Existence

Constitution

Article I

Section 1

This organization shall be known as People Like Us Neglect Gravity's Existence (P.L.U.N.G.E.)

Section 2

The purpose of this organization will be to foster interest in the pastime of juggling, to promote participation in this pastime, and to provide a medium for those interested in improving their juggling skills.

Article II

Section 1

Membership in *P.L.U.N.G.E.* shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who have any interest in learning more about, or participating in, the pastime of juggling.

Section 2

Membership in the club will be as non-selective as possible; any and all students are encouraged to become members. Anyone who has any interest in juggling, even if they just think it is "neat," are completely welcome to join.

Article III

Section 1

The elective officers of this club will be known as the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section II

The officers of this club shall be selected through election. Any candidate running for a position must obtain at least 50% of the popular vote for a given position. In the case of no candidates receiving a majority vote, the top two vote receivers will run against each other in a run-off.

Elections shall be held September 1st of the fall semester, and terms shall run for one full year. If a vacant office needs to be filled before the September 1st election, the President shall appoint acting officers.

Article IV

Section I

There will be no mandatory dues for this club.

Article V

Section I

Amendments to the Constitution must be presented at a club meeting where all four executive officers are present. In order for the amendment to pass, a vote must occur not less than one month after the amendments have been proposed. The amendment must receive at least 70% of the club support, and must three of the four executive officer's approval, where the disagreeing executive officer CANNOT be the President.

Article VI

Section I

The club shall meet weekly at a time convenient for the majority of the members. The frequency and timing of club meetings can be varied to suit the needs of the club.

Article VII

Section I

When special committees are needed, the four executive officers will appoint volunteers to a committee, as well as a committee head.

Article VIII

Section I

All managerial decisions made by the club must have the majority support of the executive officers. In the event of a tie, the President's vote breaks the tie.
