Constitution

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Perl Mongers.

Section 2 The purpose of this club will be to promote Perl on campus, allow Perl programmers to gather and trade information, and introduce others to the Perl programming language.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in Perl. Non-students who are interested in joining may become associate members.

Section 2 All students who attend Perl Mongers meetings may become members at their request.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elective officer for this club shall be President. The President will appoint further officers to fulfill the roles of Treasurer, Publicity Officer, and form committees as necessary.

Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning May 1st.

Article IV Dues

Section 1 No dues shall be charged for membership or normal Perl Mongers meetings. Special events may have fees unrelated to yearly dues.

Article V Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members shall be present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1 The club shall meet at least once a month during the fall and spring, with actual dates determined by the club membership or president each semester.
