Constitution

September 17, 2000

I. Name and Purpose

A. This organization shall be known as Providence@Campus. We are the college ministry of Providence Baptist Church.

B. The purpose of this club is:

"We will be college students who bring glory to God by seeking Him by worshipping in Spirit in truth, serving Him by loving others, and sharing Him by witnessing to all."

II. Membership

A. Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students.

B. Membership is allowed for anyone. However, our church does have requirements for membership: person must have a personal testimony of how Christ has saved them, followed in obedience in believers baptism, taken a membership class and be presented before the church. We do not require these steps to be taken to be involved in Providence@Campus.

III. Officers

- A. The elective officers for this club shall be the students who show spiritual maturity. There will be four officers:
 - 1. President: The president shall attend leadership meetings and be active in selecting a choosing other candidates.
 - 2. Vice President: This person will be the primary helper of the president.
 - 3. Secretary: This leadership position will be involved in all areas just helping out where needed.
 - 4. Outreach Team Coordinator: This leader will be responsible for ideas for outreach, and also for getting the permits needed to do outreach on campus. This person will also have an outreach team to organize.

- 5. Praise Team Leader-This person will be responsible for getting the songs together each week and leading the praise band.
- B. The officers will be chosen by staff and student leaders, and they will serve a term of one year starting in the Fall semester and ending in the next Fall.

IV. Dues

A. There are no dues to be paid to be involved with this organization.

V. Amending the Constitution and Bylaws

A. Amendments must be presented before the leadership of the group. Amendments must be true to the Word of God.

VI. Meeting Requirements

A. This club will have two main meetings during the week: H20 For those who thirst is every Saturday, and CBS is every Sunday (both are held at Providence Baptist Church). Bible studies will be offered weekly also. Attendance at meetings is suggested, but not required.

VII. Committees

A. Committee involvement will be totally voluntary. When new events/things are needed, Providence@Campus reserves the right to begin new committees.
