An Example for Club Constitutions

The Raleigh Chapter of the Governor's school Alumni Association Club constitution 3/31/08

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the Raleigh Chapter of the Governor's school Alumni Association.

Section 2

The purpose of this club shall be to organize local reunions of Governor's School alumni.

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in or have attended the Governor's school program.

Section 2

People wishing to become members must be N.C. state students. They are allowed join after an application process.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Vice President, Public Relations Chief and Treasurer.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning April 1st.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

The club will elect a committee annually responsible to organize a GS reunion.
