Sluggy Fan Club Constitution

Club Name and Purpose: This club is a fan club dedicated to, but not limited to, the on-line comic <u>www.sluggy.com</u> by Pete Abrams. It is known as the 'Sluggy Fan Club'. The purpose of this organization is to spread the joy of Sluggy.com and other excellent comics that show appropriate wit.

Membership Requirements: A member of the 'Sluggy Fan Club' must have an interest, but not necessarily a beforehand knowledge of, <u>www.Sluggy.com</u>. We allow active membership only for regularly enrolled students, faculty, and staff of North Carolina State University as per University rules. Membership shall be open to anybody, and will only be revoked when a member becomes a liability or a disturbance. "While any student member of this organization or activity is on probation, as described in the current Suspension Policy, that student member will be expected to not serve in any leadership, performance, or representation capacity which involves a significant responsibility and time commitment away from academic work."¹

Officers and Duties:

<u>President</u>: The President is in charge of planning activities, for choosing meeting places for the club, and for heading the advertising campaign. <u>Vice-President</u>: The Vice-President Officer is in charge of public relations and recruiting new members. The Vice-President will also lend assistance to the President as is needed.

<u>Treasurer</u>: The Treasurer will be in charge of collecting any funds that are allocated to the club and for organizing fundraisers and any money raised by the club members.

<u>Recreation</u>: The Recreation Officer is in charge of arranging for snacks at each meetings and a meal when that is required for a large meeting. They will also share responsibility for posting fliers and advertising.

Election Procedures: There are four officer positions, and each year there will be an opportunity to elect a new member to an office. The elections will be held at the beginning of each school year. The same

person may hold the same office consecutively, but they must be voted in as per procedure.

At the beginning of the school year, there will be a meeting held where those members who wish to serve as an officer will make a bid for a specific office. The Members at Large will vote and choose which person would best fill the position.

Dues: There will be no dues required at this point.

Method of Amending Constitution: Should a member feel an amendment should be put in the constitution, they must address one of the officers with their suggestion. The officer must arrange a meeting of all the standing members and put forth the idea for the amendment. If the majority of the club feels it is needed, then it shall be added to the constitution.

Meeting Requirements: The club must meet at least twice a year. Once at the beginning of the year to vote in new members and officers, and once at the end of the year to recount all that has been done during the year and to tie up any loose ends. Any other desired meetings will be held as there is a need for them, to be determined by the President after consulting with other members to determine the exact time, place, and reason for meeting.
