Article I: Name and Purpose

Section1

 This organization shall be known as the Society of Manufacturing Engineers, NCSU Student Chapter.

Section2

The purpose of the chapter shall be:

Article II: Membership

 Membership shall be open to all the students of North Carolina State University.

Article III: Officers
