

Article I- Name and Purpose

Section I This organization shall be known as Southern Strut Dance Club.

Section II The purpose of this club shall be to provide a creative outlet for those interested in learning and performing hip hop, funk, pop, and jazz dance routines.

Article II- Membership

Section I Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in dance.

Section II Anyone interested is entitled to join the club. No tryouts will be held in order to be admitted into the club.

Article III- Officers

Section I The elective officers of this club shall be the president, vice president, secretary, and a treasurer.

Section II The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year beginning May 2006.

Article IV- Dues

Section I Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V- Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

Section I Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of two thirds of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI- Meetings

Section I The club shall meet once a week for one hour unless otherwise specified. Attendance will be taken at every meeting and a total of three absences a semester will result in demotion to inactive membership.

Article VII- Committees

Section I The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
