

Spin Club Constitution

Article 1- Name and Purpose

Section 1: This organization shall be known as the Spin Club.

Section 2: The purpose of the Spin Club at N.C. State is to provide members an opportunity to further their skills by practicing and performing the art of winter guard. It is also the purpose of this organization to entertain and enlighten the students and faculty with regular exhibition performances. In addition Spin Club also promotes the good reputation of the university by performing in competitions all over the southeast region.

Article 2 – Membership

Section 1: A Spin Club member is any enrolled student who is interested in improving and performing the art of winter guard.

Section 2: Members are selected based on their processing of a basic skill level with the craft and willingness to improve that skill level.

Article 3 – Officers

Section 1: It is the job of the Spin Club Captains to function as the main officers of the Spin Club as well as put together the season's show and schedule the dates of performance.

Section 2: The Spin Club Captains are nominated by the Spin Club and then interviewed and chosen by the Advisor.

Article 4 – Dues

Section 1: Dues are decided based on number of members and the amount of outside funding received for the year. Dues will not exceed \$30.00 per person per year.

Article 5 – Amending the Constitution

Section 1: Amendments to the constitution can be purposed by any member at a practice and will only pass with a 2/3 majority vote from the entire Spin Club.

Article 6 – Practices and Performances

Section 1: Practices are to be held twice a week for 2 hours at a time which accommodates the schedules of the majority of the members of the Spin Club.

Section 2: Performances in competitions and on campus exhibitions number, date and locations for performances will be announced at the beginning of each season.
