Constitution

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the Statistics Club of North Carolina State University

Section 2

The purpose of this club shall be the education and unification of undergraduate students in the Statistics Department.

Article II Membership and Meeting Attendance

Section 1

All undergraduate students majoring or minoring in Statistics will be members.

Section 2

Meetings shall be open to all regularly enrolled undergraduate students who show interest in statistics by majoring in Statistics, minoring in Statistics, or taking a Statistics class in the current semester.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary. The Faculty Advisor will be selected by the Statistics Department.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in the fall semester. All officers may be reelected as many times as he or she is elected by the Statistics Club.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

All meetings will be free to those in attendance.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The Statistics Club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

The Statistics Club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
