Constitution

Article I

Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the Student Association of Black Social Workers.

Section 2

The purpose(s) of this club shall (will) be to meet other social work students, establish networks with other students and work groups, and establish relationships with professional organizations, i.e. National Association of Social Workers and National Association of Black Social Workers.

Article II

Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in fulfilling the purpose of this organization and becoming involved in the activities, which will include guest speakers, student advisories, and study groups.

Section 2

Means of selection of members. Members shall (will) be African-American Social Work student majors, faculty, staff, and all others are welcome.

Article III

Officers

Section 1

The elective officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Student at Large.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning March (Spring semester) with present officers serving as mentors until the end of the semester.

Article IV Dues
Section 1 Dues shall be \$10(optional) per year for membership in the Triangle and the National Association of Social Workers.

Article V Amending the Constitution and By-laws
Section 1 Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be voted on by the majority of the members present.

Article VI Meetings
Section 1 The organization shall meet monthly unless otherwise specified.

Article VII Committees
Section 1 The organization shall make provisions for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
