

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I	Name and Purpose	
	Section 1	This organization shall be known as the Student Organization of Lions Club
	Section 2	The purpose of this club will be to create opportunity for community service specifically in the area of visually impaired but not limited to the exclusion of other campus and community service opportunity.
ARTICLE II	Membership	
	Section 1	Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in the activities of the club.
	Section 2	Means of selection of members. The club shall select the method by which membership in the club shall be approved.
ARTICLE III	Officers	
	Section 1	The elective officers for this club shall be President, Secretary and Treasurer.
	Section 2	The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning July 1, 2003.
ARTICLE IV	Dues	
	Section 1	Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments that will not be more than \$38 annually.
ARTICLE V	Amending the Constitution and By-Laws	
	Section 1	Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.
ARTICLE VI	Meetings	
	Section 1	The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.
ARTICLE VII	Committees	
	Section 1	The club shall make provision for any special committees when needed.
