Constitution

Article I Name and Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be known as Student Peace Action Network (SPAN).

Section 2 The purpose of this organization is to facilitate communication to forge a more popular and diverse student peace movement. SPAN seeks to cultivate an acute awareness among young people regarding the connections between complex webs of military corporate power and the steady fast decay of democracy and peace in the United States as well as globally.

Span is supported by PEACE ACTION education fund, the nation's largest grass roots peace and justice organization.

SPAN is a tool for diverse student groups to obtain current information on the peace movement and a space for students to forge their own strategic campaigns and visions and to challenge injustice of our current national agenda.

Article II Membership

Section 1 SPAN welcomes all student groups and individuals to tap into SPAN to obtain reliable resources and organizational building tools, to engage in national actions and campaigns

(SPAN) in conjunction with the network, and to share strategies used in the community with other students around the U.S.

Article III Officers

Name and Purpose Article I

Action Section 1 The elective officers of this club shall be president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer,

Section 2 The officers shall serve a term of one year, beginning in January.

Section 1 Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V Amending the States as well as globally.

Constitution Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be and by-laws presented by members of the club in writing and Section 1 read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the purpose of amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings The club shall meet as determined by the club membership.
