Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as North Carolina State University Students for McCain

Section 2

The purposes of this club shall be to help John McCain be elected as the next president of the United States and to inform and educate N.C. State students about Senator John McCain

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who support John McCain and are interested in working to have him elected.

Section 2

Membership dues shall be \$2.00 per member.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elected officers for this club shall be the executive director, executive administrator, communications director, secretary, and volunteer coordinator.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of ninety days beginning September 7, 2008.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

Dues for the club shall be \$2.00 per semester -or- dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club shall meet as determined by its members and executive committee concerning events, presidential debates, and volunteering.
