#### Article I Name & Purpose

##### Section 1

This organization shall be known as Students for Pat McCrory

##### Section 2

The purpose of this club shall be to serve as the official student liaison of this University to the Elect Pat McCrory for Governor Campaign. ...

#### Article II Membership

##### Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in helping elect Pat McCrory the next governor of North Carolina

##### Section 2

Means of selection of members. Students for Pat McCrory is open to any student enrolled in at this institution, full or part time.

#### Article III Officers

##### Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be the selected at the first meeting.

##### Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning at the first meeting.

#### Article IV Dues

##### Section 1

There shall be no dues or fees involved with membership in Students for Pat McCrory

---

#### Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

##### Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
