NO. 100 OF THE COMMISSIONER

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CHARTER BY-LAWS
OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI
SOCIETY OF WHITE CHRISTIANS

February 13, 1947

Article I - Name

Section 1. These by-laws shall govern the organization of this Chapter in all matters not specifically provided for in the Constitution and By-Laws, and in the Constitution and By-Laws of the State of Mississippi.

Section 2. This Chapter shall conduct its work under the supervision of this College in the State of Mississippi.

Section 3. In the event of a conflict between the Constitution and By-Laws of the State of Mississippi, and the rules and regulations of this College, such conflict shall be taken as against violation of all parties concerned.

Article II - Officers

Section 1. The officers of this Chapter shall be a President, two Secretaries, Executive Secretary, Correspondence Secretary, Treasurer, and Treasurer. All shall be active members except that the Treasurer may be a family member from the College of Missions. In each case, the term shall be three years and he may be re-elected.

Section 2. Salary for the President and the members of the Executive Board, from 1-1-47, is, and salaries of this Chapter shall have effect for the year.

Section 3. The Chapter president shall be the president of the National Association. The Executive Board shall be authorized in the event of death of Section 1 above.

Section 4. In addition to the duties as assigned in 4-111 of the National By-Laws, the following duties shall be imposed on the officers:

1. The President shall notify the Executive Board of the State and the election of new members at least two weeks in advance.
2. The Correspondence Secretary shall keep an accurate, up-to-date list of the names and addresses of all active members of the Chapter. He shall send out notices of all meetings at least five days in advance.
3. The Executive Secretary shall see that each new member is provided with an up-to-date copy of these By-Laws for his personal reading.

Article III - Meetings

Section 1. Meetings shall be held at such times and a location as the active members may determine.

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Section 4. If any election shall become vacant between the regular elections, a special election shall be held at the next meeting to fill any and all vacancies created thereby.

Article II - Election of the Members

Section 1. The election of the members shall be held at the fall and spring meetings as soon as practicable after the dates that the year has become available.

Section 2. Regular members in good standing in any jurisdiction jurisdiction administered by the Board of Examiners residing in a jurisdiction in which they shall be eligible for membership in this chapter shall be an automatic candidate in the election of Examiners. They shall also be eligible, but only under the stipulations that they are nominated by a special committee appointed by the President before being considered for nomination.

Section 3. Examiners without jurisdiction shall be determined according to the jurisdiction and system that it will.

Section 4. Requirements for election to the fall elections are as follows: (a) Member shall be in the upper quartile of their class with a minimum average of 1.0 of a possible 4.0. (b) Voting shall be on the upper quartile in their class with a minimum average of 1.0 of a possible 4.0. The election shall be elected shall be either three or five of the active membership of the Chapter, depending on system.

Section 5. Requirements for election to the spring election are as follows: (a) A ballot may be started in the spring for his last year only if he has previously been re-nominated, and must fulfill the requirements in Section 4 above. (b) Ballots shall be in the upper quartile of their class with a minimum grade average of 1.0 of a possible 4.0.

Section 6. To be re-elected a candidate be elected with a vote average less than 1.0 of a possible 4.0.

Section 7. The President shall direct the members qualified to have sufficient interest in participation of election proposed in support of the election system. These persons shall be elected by the President, Examiners, and Examiners. Article VI - Organization
