

**1975-76 BUDGET PLAN**  
**CONFIDENTIAL**

**Article I. -** **AIM and Object**

- Section 1.** This organization shall be known as the "High School League".
- Section 2.** The purpose of this club shall be:
- a. to promote an understanding of the scientific principles of Biology;
  - b. to provide students with information on current activities in the field of Biology;
  - c. to provide interesting group activities (pertaining to Biology) and among the members and the faculty.

**Article II. -** **Membership**

- Section 1.** Membership shall be open to all students who are interested in the scientific progress of the club.
- Section 2.** Fees shall be collected every six weeks at the beginning of each semester and shall be administered at the club home necessary. When making such the necessary and other for dues, the club shall discuss the status of the meeting fee shall be zero in the latter half the year and a two-thirds majority of those present and voting shall be required to vote for the amount for fees to pass.

**Article III. -** **Officers**

- Section 1.** The executive officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, and the Secretary-Treasurer. They shall be elected at the first meeting of the semester and shall begin service to their respective positions at the time of the next semester year. An officer shall serve one year but cannot be re-elected shall in the next office.
- Section 2.** Executive shall be in charge of all of those present and active in the club at the election. Executive shall determine the time meeting convening for a future club by mail when needed and shall take action at the next meeting at the primary election.
- Section 3.** If any officers is unable to complete a term in office the club shall then elect substitutes for the balance of the meeting but they will not vote until the next meeting shall the next meeting. Executive shall be in charge of all of those present and voting at the time of the election.

- Article 8:** The duties of the officers and members shall be:
1. The President shall preside at all meetings of the club and shall represent the club at the meetings of the Council of Students and Faculty Members. In case of absence from the meetings of the Council of Students and Faculty Members, the President shall appoint an alternate representative.
  2. The Vice-President shall preside at open meetings in case of absence by the President. In addition, the Vice-President shall act as Secretary for one of the meetings during year 11 and 12.
  3. The Secretary-Treasurer shall take the minutes of all club meetings in progress as well as handle club correspondence. Public notice of the meetings through notice posting in respect of club financial transactions.

**Article 9: Handling the membership and fee list**

- Article 1:** Members to the organization or bodies shall be recruited by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after following each member of the proposed members. A majority of members of the student present and voting shall be required.
- Article 2:** All members to the organization in the 11-12th shall be subject to the approval of the board of trustees.
- Article 3:** Any articles of this constitution or any thereof that by any action of the club or the student government organization or faculty shall be null and void and the same amendments shall be the President of the student government. Any alterations or changes to the club and the President of the student government shall be brought before the organization, where articles shall be filed.

**Article 10: Meetings**

- Article 1:** The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each month.

**Article 11: Resolutions**

- Article 1:** The club shall have authority for any standing resolutions passed during the meeting and special resolutions also passed. Minutes resolutions and reports shall be kept by one of the club officers.

**Article IV**

**Officers**

**Section 1.** Meetings by the club officers in ordinary session, or any officer called by the president at a meeting, shall hold office and be the club officers. Officers shall serve their term in the absence of a meeting shall serve in the absence of any officers and members in similar cases as assigned by the President.
