

## **The First Student Association Constitution**

### **Article I - Name**

Section 1. The name of the organization shall be "The Student Association" and its abbreviation shall be "FSDA" and the organization shall be located at North Carolina State University, Raleigh, North Carolina, U.S.A.

### **Article II - Objectives**

Section 1. The objective of this association is:

Section 1.1 to foster a close relationship and help build self during studies among the students at North Carolina State University.

Section 1.2 to participate with the management student activities.

Section 1.3 to perform various administrative responsibility.

### **Article III - Membership**

Section 1. The students residing at North Carolina State University shall be considered as a membership.

### **Article IV - Administrative officers**

Section 1. The administrative officers shall consist of President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2. President shall be elected by general election from members. Presidential election shall be held each year within the first 30 days of Fall semester.

**Article 11 - Activities**

**Section 1.** The Thai Student Association shall hold at least one regular meeting each semester of which part the conducting activities and promoting professional and other valuable programs.

**Section 2.** Special meetings may be called to regular meetings may be cancelled or postponed for the administrative officials when such action is for the best interest of Thai Student Association.

**Section 3.** Quorum for the meetings shall be at least one-third (1/3) of the members.

**Article 12 - Amendments**

**Section 1.** Proposed amendments shall be submitted to and approved by the administrative officials.

**Section 2.** The proposed amendments shall be adopted and shall be a regular meeting for consideration and vote.

**Section 3.** The alternative vote by recorded ballot system shall be approved for the approval.
