

## **Triangle College's Antiracism Project (2014)**

### **Introduction**

#### **Article 1: Goals and Purpose**

**Section 1:** This organization shall be known as the Triangle College Antiracism Project.

**Section 2:** The purpose of this club shall be to provide antiracism education to a possible future and to raise antiracismists in its future.

#### **Article 2: Membership**

**Section 1:** Membership shall be open to all registered students who are interested in antiracism education and social justice and open to other invited guests.

**Section 2:** Any person meeting the above criteria can join and that his membership may be terminated.

**Section 3:** That any time a member chooses to leave that they cannot withdraw their club activity, the member may be asked to leave and will not be allowed to re-join absent any TCU club event.

#### **Article 3: Officers**

**Section 1:** The elected officers to the club shall be President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary. The president will be responsible for the general running of the group and for attending all meetings. The vice president will be responsible for attending meetings when and to take care for the president in the event of the president's absence. The Treasurer will be responsible for the handling of funds and the social financing of the group. The Secretary will be responsible for maintaining the club's website and updating members of all the relevant and pertinent information.

**Section 2:** The officers electing to the group will serve a one year term. Elections will take place during the first official meeting of the full committee after spring break, after an organizational meeting. Officers will be elected immediately to those positions at the first official meeting. Officers will have immediate responsibility to serve their term.

**Section 3:** Any member is eligible to run for office and may do so by declaring their intent to the group during the first organizational meeting or may also declare their intent at will the election.

#### **Article 4: Code**

**Section 1:** There will be no harassment, such as sexual. Officers will be responsible to the president and vice president and can be removed from membership or disaffiliated. It is possible for the club to not be charged during the semester.

#### **Article 5: Amending the Constitution and Bylaws**

**Section 1:** Amendments to the constitution or to these rules be presented by members of the club to the president or vice president and will be voted at the next business meeting.

**Section 2:** The vote for amendments shall be taken orally. To be passed, a majority will be required, provided, or 75% will vote in favor of the club's meeting following the proposal.

**Section 3:** The amendments will pass only will be presented to the members of the committee if it receives a 75% vote of either will the members' attendance.
