

Franchise (Intergroup Administrations) (2014)

Constitution

Article I: Name and Purpose

Section 1: The organization shall be known and as the Franchise (Intergroup Administrations) (FIA).

Section 2: The purpose of the club shall be to promote entrepreneurship in a positive manner and to engage in intergrouping of all cultures.

Article II: Membership

Section 1: Membership consists open to all regulars provided students and employees in administration, academic or related subjects and their families from various groups.

The treasurer will be responsible for the keeping of funds and the financial needs of the club. The secretary will be responsible for the maintaining of club documents and conducting a record of all the club's activities and discussions.

Section 2: The officers also have to give a group orientation to incoming freshers. Officers will also assist along with other members of the club members after getting back, also on responsibilities involving. Officers will be immediately available to others present during the free time. However, Officers will not communicate before or during their break.

Section 3: Any member is eligible to run for office and has the right to run for any position during the first organizational meeting or may also decline their election and the election.

Article IV: Duties

Section 1: These are the following main positions. These will be appointed by the president concerned and will get the main duties of administration in particular. It is possible to not have to be for changes during the semester.

Section 2: Electing the Committee and Bylaws
