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| | Section I: The name of the organization shall be the North Carolina State University Retirement Fund. |
| Article II | Purpose |
| | Section I: The purpose of this organization will be: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To promote and develop the various skills and techniques of teaching competence and research.2. To provide a place for the promotion of North Carolina State University interests, Communications, and liaison with other institutions. |
| Article III | Meetings |
| | Section I: The meetings of the organization will be held in student, faculty, and staff of North Carolina State University facilities as agreed to by the president and will be participating with other organizations. |
| | Section II: All individuals must comply with the university requirements as well as the chart space program requirements concerning health insurance, physical examinations, and Blue Cards, and Physical fitness Tests. |
| Article IV | Meetings |
| | Section I: All members must abide by the constitution and university policies which apply to campus organizations. |

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| Section 1: Number 1: Number 2: Number 3: | <p>The officers of the club shall consist of a president, a vice-president, treasurer, and secretary/treasurer. The officers of the organization shall be elected from and by the active members of the club. Officers of the officer shall take place at one of the meetings of the young referee.</p> |
| Section 2: Number 4: | <p>Officers and Duties</p> |
| Number 5: | <p>The President will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Preside at all club meetings. (ii) Approve or disapprove the motions passed by the club. (iii) Represent the club in official functions. (iv) Enforce all provisions of this constitution. (v) Be responsible for calculating a distribution to the various committees upon officer and committee's request. (vi) Be responsible for referring to the U.S.A. Sports Constitution in the interpretation concerning specific officer during the time "not specified" below. (vii) Be responsible for authorizing medical, health insurance, and other related expenses of cost to the various committees upon officer. (viii) Be responsible for representing the club at state and the functions. (ix) Be responsible for complying with the procedures of referee certification identified in the Club Officials Handbook. (x) Hold a minimum of all club trials, including senior and junior age categories, if the need exists. |
| Number 6: | <p>The Vice-President will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Preside at club meetings while the president is unable to attend. (ii) Be present for all new member presentations and orientations of the club. (iii) Be responsible for all club publicity. (iv) Assist the president in addition of tasks and responsibilities when necessary. |
| Number 7: | <p>The Treasurer will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Be responsible for youth player listing and developing of fees. |

| Section 19. | The Secretary/Treasurer will: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Provide all off-duty meetings relevant processes and documents from current officer (ii) Supply records of all meetings (iii) Release of minutes of last meeting (iv) Minutes or executive notes of other off-duty meetings (v) Assist the President in budget preparation (vi) To keep accurate records of all accounts and collect dues (vii) Be responsible for all approved purchases |

| Section 1. | | <p>The faculty advisor will be a member of the faculty or staff of Saint Louis University and will be appointed by the president of the club.</p> |
| Section 2. | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Monitor a minimum of three business meetings of the club, particularly the first business meetings of the fall and spring semesters and the beginning of the spring semester (ii) Approve club budgets (iii) Encourage the club on college affairs possible (iv) Supply an information source for providing guidance (v) Assist the club in making its annual budget |
| Section 21. | Officers | |
| Section 1. | | <p>Club activities will include previous, continuing current, USAID trips, and other offcampus trips. There will be a minimum of two business meetings per semester.</p> |
| Section 2. | | <p>Institute a written proposal to approval of the club's report committee.</p> |
| Section 22. | Officers | |
| Section 1. | | <p>The officers shall be elected by a majority vote of at least one half of the club membership.</p> |

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| | Article 11. | Section 11. | The officer will serve for two years and eight months being elected at the first meeting of the spring semester and taking charge pending election. |
| | | Section 12. | Officer may be removed from office by majority of at least two-thirds of the total membership, providing all members have been present at the engagement process. |
| | | Section 13. | Officer may request resignation as long as the committee of the club approves. |
| | Article 12. | Officers | |
| | | Section 1. | Officers will be determined by the club members to hold responsible a majority vote of at least one-half of the total membership, the officers will be chosen through a nomination, policy and mission statement of the club, upon confirmation. |
| | Article 13. | Amendments to the Constitution | |
| | | Section 1. | The amendments can be accepted by a majority vote of at least one-half of the total membership. |
| | | Section 2. | Officer responsible will be chosen through a nomination, policy and mission statement of the club, upon confirmation. |
| | Article 14. | By-Laws | |
| | | Section 1. | By-Laws modifications will be approved by a majority vote of at least one-half the total membership. |
| | | Section 2. | By-Laws establishing group members will be voted on by the club for a majority vote of at least one-half the total membership and approved by the faculty advisor and the club's peers members. This modification will be applied only years after that (Article 1). |
| | | Section 3. | Should the traditional fall become business as usual and a new tradition arise this will be listed with in a period of time after 45 days of the club and becomes the property of the concerned organization and officer. |
| | | Section 4. | With due notice must be in compliance with the guidelines of the club sports program of the concerned organization and officer. |
