**Article II**

**Purpose**

**Section 1.**

The purposes of this organization will be:

- A. To promote and improve the athletic skills and techniques of students competing and training;
- B. To provide a forum for athletes of North Carolina State University to meet, communicate, and promote with other athletes.

**Article III**

**Membership**

**Section 1.**

The membership of this organization will be limited to students, faculty, and staff of North Carolina State University who have an interest in the sport of athletics and are in good standing with the university.

**Section 2.**

All individuals must comply with the university requirements as well as the club sports program requirements concerning health insurance, physical examinations, and Ethics, Standards, and Physical Fitness Plans.

**Section 3.**

All members must abide by this constitution and associate with it which apply campus organizations.

**Section 4.**

All members must conduct themselves in a manner which brings credit to the Intercollegiate Athlete Union, the Intercollegiate Athletic Sports Office, and North Carolina State University.

**Article IV**

**Officers**

## Article V

- Section 1.** The officers of the club shall consist of a president, a vice president, secretary, and treasurer-in-charge.
- Section 2.** The officers of the organization shall be chosen from and by the active members of the club.
- Section 3.** Election of the officers shall take place at one of the meetings of the young women.

### Officers and Officers

- Section 1. The President will:**
- Preside at official meetings.
  - Sign and counter-sign the money received by the club.
  - Represent the club in official functions.
  - Execute all general orders of the association.
  - Be responsible for submitting a statement to the financial-institutional sports office and keeping it updated.
  - Be responsible for reporting to the Club Sports Committee in the financial-institutional sports office during the first year of school.
  - Be responsible for submitting medical, health insurance, and vision and acceptance of risk to the financial-institutional sports office.
  - Be responsible for representing the club at club sports functions.
  - Be responsible for complying with the procedures and requirements identified in the Club Sports Handbook.
  - Submit a statement of all club funds, including on-line and checking accounts, at the end of each semester.
- Section 2. The Vice President will:**
- Preside at official meetings which the president is unable to attend.
  - Be present for all new monetary procedures and signatures of the club.
  - Be responsible for all club activities.
  - Assist the president in fulfillment of duties and responsibilities whenever necessary.
- Section 3. The Secretary will:**
- Be responsible for event planning and developing of plans.

- h. Keep a running chronology and the minutes of the affairs.

Section 19. The Secretary/Secretary will:

- a. Prepare or all club meetings a book for minutes and also minutes must attend.
- b. Keep records of all meetings.
- c. Notify of members of club functions.
- d. Maintain an accurate record of other club members.
- e. Assist the President in budget preparation.
- f. To keep accurate records of all accounts and other fees.
- g. Be responsible for all approved positions.

#### Article VI.

##### Faculty Advisor

Section 1. The club advisor will be a member of the faculty or staff of North Carolina State University and will be selected by the members of the club.

Section 2. The advisor will:

- a. Attend a minimum of three business meetings of the club preferably the first business meetings of the fall and spring semesters and the last meeting of the spring semester.
- b. Approve club's functions.
- c. Accompany the club on outings whenever possible.
- d. Serve as an information source for providing guidance.
- e. Advise the club in making its yearly budget.

#### Article VII

##### Activities

Section 1. Club activities will include practices, fundraising events, field trips, and intercollegiate events.

Section 2. There will be a minimum of three business meetings per semester.

Section 3. Judicial action on appeal is required if the club opens membership.

#### Article VIII

##### Officers

Section 1. The officers shall be elected by a majority vote of at least one-half of the total membership.

- Section 11.** The officers will serve for two seasons with one officer being elected a year of the last business meeting of the spring semester and taking charge pending elections.
- Section 12.** Officers shall be recruited from within the majority of at least two-thirds of the total membership, providing all members have been notified of the appointment process.
- Section 13.** Officers may succeed themselves as long as the members of the club elect them.

**Article III.**

**Club**

- Section 1.** There will be determined by the club membership and majority of majority vote of at least one-half of the club membership and approved by the club sports committee.

**Article IV.**

**Membership in the Club**

- Section 1.** The membership can be extended by a majority vote of at least one-half of the club membership.
- Section 2.** All memberships will be membership with extremely polite and courteous approval of the club sports committee.

**Article V.**

**Bylaws**

- Section 1.** Policies and procedures will be approved by a majority vote of at least one-half the club membership.
- Section 2.** A member violating organizational rules may be voted out of the club by a majority vote of at least one-half the club membership and approved by the faculty advisor and the club sports committee. This constitution will be updated each year after the first meeting.
- Section 3.** Should the Constitution fail because business is delayed and a new constitution shall be set forth around each in a period of one year, all property of the club shall become the property of the concerned recreational sports office.
- Section 4.** All club activities must be in compliance with the guidelines of the club sports program of the concerned recreational sports office.
