

UNIVERSITY SERVICE WORKERS SUPPORT COMMITTEE
Constitution

- Article I Name and Purpose
- Section 1 This organization shall be known as the University Service Workers Support Committee.
- Section 2 The purpose of the Committee shall be to support hourly wage-earning service workers in efforts to build self-organization, improve the conditions of their work, maintain security of employment, resist job discrimination and other forms of unfair treatment, and make use of educational opportunities through the university.
- Article II Membership
- Section 1 Active membership shall be open to all students, faculty, and staff at North Carolina State University. Associate membership shall be open to persons who do not have a direct connection with the University.
- Article III Officers
- Section 1 The elective officers of this Committee shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
- Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the members of the Committee to serve a term of one year beginning the first day of October.
- Article IV Dues
- Section 1 The amount of dues assessed will be determined by two-thirds majority vote of those members in attendance and voting at a regular meeting of the Committee. The meeting at which dues are determined shall be advertised in advance as such.
- Section 2 Collection of dues shall be the responsibility of the Treasurer.

Constitution

- Article I Name and Purpose
 Section 1 This organization shall be known as the University Service Workers Support Committee.
- Section 2 The purpose of the Committee shall be to support hourly wage-earning service workers in efforts to build self-organization, improve the conditions of their work, maintain security of employment, resist job discrimination and other forms of unfair treatment, and make use of educational opportunities through the university.
- Article II Membership
 Section 1 Active membership shall be open to all students, faculty, and staff at North Carolina State University. Associate membership shall be open to persons who do not have a direct connection with the University.
- Article III Officers
 Section 1 The elective officers of this Committee shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
- Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the members of the Committee to serve a term of one year beginning the first day of October.
- Article IV Dues
 Section 1 The amount of dues assessed will be determined by two-thirds majority vote of those members in attendance and voting at a regular meeting of the Committee. The meeting at which dues are determined shall be advertised in advance as such.
- Section 2 Collection of dues shall be the responsibility of the Treasurer.

Article V Amending the
Constitution &
By-Laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the Committee in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of two-thirds of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings
Section 1

The Committee shall meet as determined by the membership each semester.

Article VII Committees
Section 1

The Committee shall make provision for any standing or special committees as needs arise.
