## UNIVERSITY SERVICE WORKERS SUPPORT COMMITTEE Constitution

Article I Name and Purpose

Section 1 This organization shall be known as the University Service

Workers Support Committee.

Section 2 The purpose of the Committee shall be to support hourly

wage-earning service workers in efforts to build selforganization, improve the conditions of their work, maintain security of employment, resist job discrimination and other forms of unfair treatment, and make use of educational opportunities through the university.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Active membership shall be open to all students, faculty,

and staff at North Carolina State University. Associate membership shall be open to persons who do not have a

direct connection with the University.

Article III Officers

Section 1 The elective officers of this Committee shall be the

President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the members of the

Committee to serve a term of one year beginning the first

day of October.

Article IV <u>Dues</u>

Section 1 The amount of dues assessed will be determined by two-

thirds majority vote of those members in attendance and voting at a regular meeting of the Committee. The meeting at which dues are determined shall be advertised in advance

as such.

Section 2 Collection of dues shall be the responsibility of the

Treasurer.

### Article V Amer

Amending the Constitution &

By-Laws

#### Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the Committee in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of two-thirds of the members present and voting shall be required.
