

**CONSTITUTION**  
**WOLFPACK CLOGGING TEAM**

**ARTICLE I. NAME**

Section 1. This organization shall be known as the Wolfpack Clogging Team.

**ARTICLE II. PURPOSE**

Section 1. The purpose of this organization will be:

- A. To promote the art and tradition of clogging through performances, workshops and competitions

**ARTICLES III. MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1. Membership shall be open to all regular enrolled students who are interested in clogging.

Section 2. Membership becomes effective after completion of all required forms and auditions.

**ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS**

Section 1. The officers of this organization shall be chosen from and by the active members of the organization

Section 2. The officers shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasure, and Faculty Director.

**ARTICLE V. DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

Section 1. The President shall:

- (A) enforce all provisions of this Constitution.
- (B) be responsible for submitting an organization roster and medical, insurance, and release and assumption of risk forms to the Director.
- (C) schedule and conduct all business meetings.

Section 2. The Vice President shall:

- (A) assume duties of President during his or her absence.

- (B) assist the President when needed.
- (C) handle all publicity for organization functions.

Section 3. The Secretary shall:

- (A) be present to take minutes of meetings.
- (B) conduct correspondence for the organization.
- (C) notify members of organization functions.

Section 4. The Treasurer shall:

- (A) keep an accurate record of all accounts.
- (B) assist the President in budget preparation.

Section 5. The Faculty Director shall:

- (A) attend all business meetings of the organization.
- (B) approve all organization functions.
- (C) serve as a source for providing direction.
- (D) assist members in planning of yearly budgets.

ARTICLE VI. ELECTION

Section 1. The officers will be elected by a 2/3 vote of at least 1/2 of the total membership.

Section 2. The officers shall serve for one year with new officers being elected at the first business meeting of the fall semester and taking charge pending election.

Section 3. Officers may be removed from office by 2/3 vote of all active members.

Section 4. Officers may succeed themselves as long as the members of the organization elect them.

ARTICLE VII. DUES

Section 1. Dues shall be determined by the organization and passed by 2/3 vote of the entire membership.

ARTICLE VIII.     ACTIVITIES

Section 1.     Activities will include organization workshops, fund raising events, and other related activities.

Section 2.     There will be a minimum of two business meetings of the organization held per semester.

Section 3.     All organization activities are subject to approval by the organization Director.

ARTICLE IX.     Amending the Constitution and By-laws

Section 1.     Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
