

# **NCSU Figure Skating Club Constitution**

February 25, 2006

## **Article I**

### *Section 1*

This organization shall be known as the NCSU Figure Skating Club.

### *Section 2*

The purposes of this club shall be

- to offer NC State students an opportunity to learn and develop basic skating skills
- to represent NC State University within the United States Figure Skating Association
- to provide a unique feature for NC State prospective students
- to create a fun atmosphere that promotes physical fitness

## **Article II**

### *Section 1*

- Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in figure skating and learning basic skating skills.

### *Section 2*

- Membership will be recognized upon payment of club dues.

## **Article III**

### *Section 1*

- The elective officers for this club shall be the president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer.

### *Section 2*

- The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning at the start of fall semester.

## **Article IV**

### *Section 1*

- Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

## **Article V**

### *Section 1*

- Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

#### **Article VI**

##### *Section 1*

- The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

#### **Article VII**

##### *Section 1*

- The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.

#### **Article VIII**

##### *Section 1*

- Policies and procedures will be approved by a majority vote of the members present to vote.
- A member exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct may be voted out of the club by a majority vote of the members present to vote.
