## **Wolfpack Majorettes**

#### Constitution

## Article I Name and Purpose

- Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Wolfpack Majorettes.
- Section 2 The purpose of this club shall be:
  - -To educate NC State students, as well as the community about baton twirling techniques.
  - -To teach sportsmanship and teamwork.
  - -To encourage self-esteem and confidence.
  - -To perform baton twirling routines during the NC State University Marching Band's performances.
  - -To compete in baton twirling contests throughout the year.

# Article II Membership

- Section 1 1. Active membership shall be open to all regular enrolled students and faculty.
  - 2. Associate membership is open to all persons who do not have a connection with the university.
- Section 2

  1. Members that tryout for the North Carolina State Marching Band's Majorettes, and make the squad, will be part of the Wolfpack Majorettes' performance team.
  - Members that tryout for the performance team must meet the membership requirements of the North Carolina State University Marching Band.
  - 3. Only the members of the performance team will be able to perform during the NCSU Marching Band performances and at the twirling competitions throughout the year.

### Article III Officers and Elections

- **Section 1** 1. The elective officers for this club shall be:
  - A. President

#### Duties:

- 1. Preside over the club meetings.
- 2. Organize the events of the meetings.
- 3. Organize the activities of the club.
- B. Vice President

#### Duties:

- 1. Assist the President in organizing the meetings.
- Preside over club meetings if the President can not attend the meetings.
- Assist the President in organizing the activities of the club.
- C. Secretary

### Duties:

- 1. Maintain the official club Constitution and Bylaws.
- 2. Take notes during meetings.
- 3. Preside over the election of officers.
- D. Treasurer

### Duties:

- 1. Maintain accurate records of all club financial transactions.
- 2. Submit accurate financial reports to the President if requested.
- 2. Only active members may become officers of the club.
- Section 2 1. Elections will be held in the Fall Semester of each year.
  - All members of the club will be eligible to make officer nominations.
  - All members of the club will be eligible to vote in the elections.
  - The President will have the power to break ties on all voting matters.

### Article IV Amending the constitution and Bylaws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or bylaws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read in a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.

# Article V Meetings

Section 1

- 1. At least four meetings shall be held each year.
- 2. Two meetings shall be held each Fall and Spring Semester.
- 3. The officers will decide on the meeting times and places.
