Wolfpack N.O.W. (National Organization for Women)

Constitution

Article I	Name & Purpose	This organization will be known as Wolfpack N.O.W. The purpose of this organization is to help increase educational, employment, and business opportunities for women, and make tougher laws on violence, harassment, and discrimination.
Article II	<u>Membership</u>	Membership will be offered to all regularly enrolled students who support our purpose and pay the required dues.
Article III	Officers	The elective officers of Wolfpack N.O.W. will be President (presides over meetings), Vice President (responsible for membership, PR), Secretary (keeps minutes of meetings; handles correspondence), Treasurer (collect dues, manages budget). The officers will be elected by club members to serve one year terms each fall semester.
Article IV	Dues	Wolpack N.O.W. requires each member to pay \$15.00 once a year.
Article V	Amending the Co	Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next meeting. Voting will be done by the members present at that meeting.
Article VI	Meetings	Meetings will be held monthly on campus.
Article VII	Commitees	Wolfpack N.O.W. will form committees as needed to fulfill duties and responsibilities of the organization.

Wolfpack NOW (National Organization for Women) Constitution

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as Wolfpack NOW.

Section 2

The purpose of this organization is to help increase awareness of women's issues on campus and in the community, including, but not limited to, violence against women, reproductive rights, educational and economic equality and freedom from all discrimination.

Article II Membership

Section 1 Membership is open to all students at NC State that support our cause.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers of Wolfpack NOW shall be: President, responsible for organizing and presiding over meetings, activities, and events unless responsibility is delegated otherwise Vice President, responsible for assisting the President in organization and planning of meetings, activities, and events Secretary, responsible for taking and reporting the minutes of each meeting Publicity Officer, responsible for advertising Wolfpack NOW meetings, activities, and events, including arranging press when necessary Web Producer, responsible for building and maintaining a Wolfpack

Section 2

NOW website

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one school year beginning in September and ending in May.

Article IV Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article V Meetings

Section 1 Meetings shall be held once every two weeks or as needed.

Article VI Committees

Section 1 Committees shall be formed by members for specific tasks and duties as needed.
