

Wolves D.I.N. Constitution

Article I – Name and Purpose

- Section 1 This organization shall be known as the Wolves D.I.N.
Section 2 The purpose of this club shall be to promote music on campus.

Article II – Membership

- Section 1 Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students or alumni who are interested in music.
Section 2 Membership shall be approved based upon regular attendance and participation at meetings

Article III – Officers

- Section 1 The officers of this organization shall consist of 5 officers including: A president who shall oversee and maintain the direction in which the Wolves D.I.N. progresses, as well as make executive decisions pertaining to the club; A vice-president who shall take on the position of the president in the event of the president's absence; A treasurer who shall keep track of the organizations finances; Two independent committee heads whose roles are further defined in Article VII; A secretary who shall keep track of minutes and maintain the organizations archives.
Section 2 To qualify for an executive office, an individual must have served on and taken an active role in a committee.
Section 3 Each office shall be for a term of one school year, beginning in the fall semester.
Section 4 To run for election, an individual must first be approved by the executive board of officers, through a mandatory interview process.
Section 5 Provisions for removal of an officer shall be through a 2/3 majority approval through the remaining executive board of officers.

Article IV – Dues

- Section 1 There are no dues necessary to be within the Wolves D.I.N.

Article V – Amending the Constitution and By-Laws

- Section 1 The constitution may be amended by a 2/3 majority vote

Article VI – Meetings

- Section 1 Regular meetings of this organization shall be held at least every month. The secretary shall be responsible for notifying members of this meeting.

Article VII – Committees

- Section 1 There shall be two committees. The Committee for Publicity and Promotions shall take on the responsibility of event promotions (i.e. flyers, advertisements, word of mouth, etc). The Committee for Events Coordination shall take on the responsibility of organizing the events (i.e. venue reservation, organizing bands, etc).
