Constitution

Article I

This organization shall be known as the North Carolina State University's Women's Ultimate Frisbee team, or Disc-o.

The purposes of this club will be to have an organized team and play Ultimate Frisbee according to the rules and regulations set by the Ultimate Players Association (UPA). The women who are members of this organization are expected to hold dedication to the team by attending practices and tournaments regularly while keeping a positive and respective attitude towards the sport.

Article II

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in playing and learning how to play Ultimate Frisbee.

The club shall select members by people who regularly come to practice and show a positive attitude towards learning the sport of Ultimate Frisbee.

Article III

The elective officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. If the club feels that any more officers are needed, they should vote on the new position and proceed with the normal process of filling a position.

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year. Elections are to be held during the Spring Semester, but are not to take effect until the following fall semester of the same calendar year.

Article IV

The dues for the club shall be in the amount of \$8.00 per semester

of participation. If a member chooses to participate in a UPA event, (which the club does participate in), she will also be responsible for covering the UPA membership fee.

Article V

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting, but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of two-thirds of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI

The club shall meet for practice at least two times per week at the times and days at the discretion of the officers and members.
