## World Tae Kwon Do Association Constitution

Article I	Name and Purpose	
	Section 1	This organization shall be known as the World Tae Kwon Do Association Club at North Carolina State University.
	Section 2	The purpose of this club shall be to strengthen the minds and bodies of its members through the study of a traditional martial art.
Article II	Membership	
	Section 1	Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in the art and sport of tae kwon do.
	Section 2	Upon achieving the yellow belt status, all club members will become lifetime members of the World Tae Kwon Do Association.
Article III	Officers	
	Section 1	The elective officers of this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
	Section 2	The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning in August of each year.
Article IV	Dues	
	Section 1	Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.
Article V	Amending the Constitution By-laws	
	Section 1	Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.
Article VI	Meetings Section 1	The club shall meet at least biweekly for practice. Meeting days and times will be determined at the beginning of each semester.
Article VII	<b>Responsibilities</b>	
	Section 1	Members will comply with all rules of the World Tae Kwon Do Association, both obeying instructors and respecting fellow members.
