

College Leadership for Greater Raleigh Young Life Constitution
August 5, 2004

Article I Name & Purpose

Section 1

This organization shall be known as the College Leadership for Greater Raleigh Young Life.

Section 2

The purposes of this club shall be to provide Christian fellowship and leadership training. Throughout a series of meetings during the school year there will be Bible studies, training, small groups, and speakers used to train members to be Christian leaders. In the spring semester there is a greater focus on how to do relational ministry with a special emphasis on reaching out to high school students. Halfway thru the spring semester each year members who would like to pursue being Young Life leaders in the Greater Raleigh area will have the opportunity.

Article II Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all regularly enrolled students who are interested in the purposes of the club.

Section 2

Means of selection of members. Anyone who comes is eligible for becoming a member. Those who desire to be members only need to add their information to the club's database and that action ensures their membership.

Article III Officers

Section 1

The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 2

The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one year, beginning once classes start in the fall and ended by the end of spring semester.

Article IV Dues

Section 1

Dues for the club shall be in the form of special assessments voted on by a majority of the club members present and voting.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section 1

Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member of the proposed amendments. A majority of 2/3 of the members present and voting shall be required.

Article VI Meetings

Section 1

The club shall meet as determined by the club membership each semester.

Article VII Committees

Section 1

The club shall make provision for any standing committees needed and/or for forming any special committees when needed.
