Article I Name & Purpose

Article III Officers

Section I The elective officers for this club shall be the President, Vice-President, Treasurer,

Historian, Website Designer, and Activities Coordinator.

Section 2 The officers shall be elected by the club members to serve a term of one semester.

Article IVDues

Section I There will be no dues. If there is a financial need, the members will discuss a way to

meet it, when the time arises.

Article V Amending the Constitution and by-laws

Section I Amendments to the constitution or by-laws shall be presented by members of the club in

writing and read at a regular meeting but shall not be voted upon until the next regular meeting, and then only after informing each member for the proposed amendments. A

majority of 2/3 for the members present and voting shall be required.
