Elizabeth Bobbit Lee is principal in the Lumberton, NC firm of Elizabeth B. Lee, AIA, designers of commercial, educational, and residential structures. In 1952, Ms. Lee became the first woman to receive the Bachelor of Architecture degree from NCSU. She was also the first woman to be licensed to practice architecture in North Carolina and the first woman to serve as president of the NC Chapter of the American Institute of Architects (AIA).

Ms. Lee has served as secretary, vice president, first vice president as well as president of the North Carolina Chapter of the AIA. Currently, she is a member of the board of directors of the AIA representing the South Atlantic Region, president of the NC Architectural Foundation, and a member of the board of directors of the NCSU Alumni Association.

In addition to her many professional activities, Ms. Lee has served on the boards of Robeson Little Theatre, Robeson County Community Concerts and the North Carolina Dance Theatre in Winston-Salem.
