- 2. The Crit Science Department agrees to provide facilities, including the obtaining equipment required in the conduct of the research work defined in the previous persymph.
- 3. The Group Science Department agrees to provide labor, technical and supervisor, personnel and supelias to be used in the conduct of the research, other than the herbicides which will be supplied by Amchem Products, Inc.

- 1. Amchem Products, Inc. agrees to pay the Orop Science Department the sum of fifteen hundred (\$1500) dollars to be applied to the cost of carrying out the research work under this agreement including such items as cost of labor, technical assistance, special equipment, and supplies including overhead for indirect costs.
- 2. ArCher Products, Inc. agrees to provide reasonable amounts of the herbicides referred to in Article I.

1. Detailed records of the experiment work shall be maintained by the Crop Science Department and shall be made available to AmChan Products, Inc. The Crop Science Department will render a final report at the conclusion of the work.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN
