SCHAUB 4-H CAMP

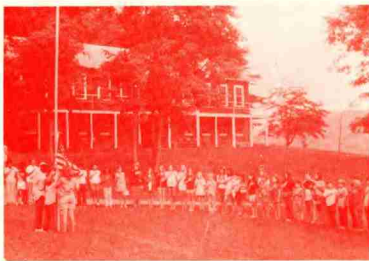
You will have fun, adventure and excitement at Schaub 4-H Camp.

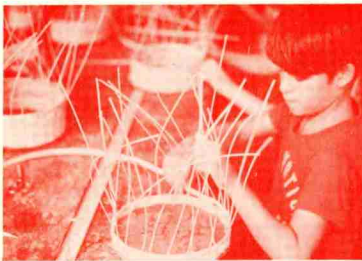

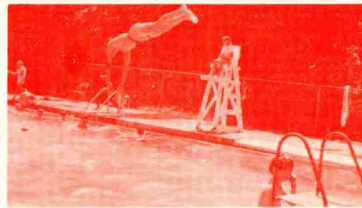
